



Welcome to the RMH Hunter Pace!

We are glad you are here and hope you enjoy the courses today.

THE COURSE OPTIONS FOR TODAY:

FULL CRY: 8 – 11 miles. To be ridden at a pace of 10 miles per hour

FIRST FLIGHT: 7 – 11 miles. To be ridden at a pace of 8 mph

HILLTOPPERS: 6 – 9 miles. To be ridden at a pace of 6 mph

The divisions above follow **BLACK ARROWS & PINK-AND-BLACK RIBBONS**

Jumps are optional on all courses

.....
STROLLERS: 4 – 6 miles to be ridden at a pace of 4 mph

STROLLERS FOLLOW RED ARROWS & RED-AND-YELLOW RIBBONS

GRAND PRIZES FOR THE SEASON

Champion: Horse cooler with RMH emblem and your name, division and year (sized for your horse)

Reserve Champion: Folding camp chair with RMH emblem and your name, division and year

General Rules:

1. Placings determined by team's ride time closest to optimum pace time (+ or -)
2. Ribbons to 6th place will be awarded in each division. They will be mailed to Rider# 1 on the entry form.
3. ***NO MORE THAN 3 RIDERS TO A TEAM*** Groups made with multiple teams may ride at the same time, however, +1 min will be added to each additional team – decided by the team(s) at the starter's table
4. Grand Prizes are awarded in each of the four divisions. Rider with the most points in the **same** division for 2022 season will be the winner. The winner **MUST** have entered minimum of 2 hunter paces in the season. In the event of a tie for points, winner will be chosen based upon total score of last hunter pace held by RMH where the score was not tied.

POINTS:

First place: 24 points
 Second place: 20 points
 Third place: 16 points

Fourth place: 12 points
 Fifth place: 8 points
 Sixth place: 4 points

Riding but not placing: 1 point

Please be a courteous Rider!

- Call out to riders when coming up upon teams, so as not to spook the horses.
- Please pass at a walk when overtaking another team.
- It is best for slower riders to yield to the faster riders by stepping off the trail and turning their horse's heads to the passing horses.
- Faster teams should not move off until a safe distance away.
- Everyone yields to Strollers.
